**I. OBLIGATIONS**

- A. Each District 6 student member (high school and junior high division) shall fulfill a \$250.00 minimum sponsorship obligation to District 6. This minimum obligation must be paid in full by the determined date for the current competition year for eligibility to enter and compete in all CHSRA rodeos and be considered a member in good standing.
- B. Each District 6 member (high school and junior high division) is obligated to participate in all required fund raisers to enter and compete in CHSRA sponsored rodeos and be considered a member in good standing. Hardships may be presented by members to the District 6 Executive Board of Directors for special considerations.
- C. Each District 6 member (high school and junior high division) must compete in 50% of the scheduled District 6 rodeos plus one rodeo to be eligible to receive year-end awards. Special circumstances will be evaluated by the District 6 Executive Board of Directors.
- D. Each District 6 family (high school and junior high division) is responsible for fulfilling volunteer work roles during the District 6 sponsored rodeos/season for their student member to be considered a member in good standing. Families shall sign up for volunteer roles during the annual membership meeting. Inventory of volunteerism shall be maintained and publicized throughout the District 6 rodeo season. Year-end awards, State Finals Rodeo entry fees and National Finals Rodeo travel subsidy awards may be revoked for members whose families fail to fulfill volunteer work obligations.

**II. FINANCES**

- A. District 6 fundraisers proceeds will be used for:
1. Year-end awards for both high school and junior high divisions – the number of year-end awards are determined annually by the District 6 Executive Board of Directors based on number of qualified contestants
  2. Scholarships for District 6 senior members who are in good standing
  3. A minimum of \$5,000.00 to be held to begin the subsequent rodeo season
  4. CHSRA State Finals Rodeo Qualifiers (high school and junior high division) – State Finals Rodeo entry fees will be reimbursed to qualifying District 6 student members who are in good standing. Any other award subsidies are at the discretion of the District 6 Executive Board of Directors
    - a) Top five (5) members in each event qualify for the CJHSRA (Junior High) State Finals Rodeos and Top six (6) members in each event qualify for the CHSRA (High School) State finals rodeos.
  5. NHSRA National Finals Rodeo Qualifiers (high school and junior high division) – Travel subsidy awards may be awarded to District 6 members who are good standing and have qualified for NHSRA National Finals Rodeo. Travel subsidy awards will be determined annually by the District 6 Executive Board of Directors based on District 6 fundraising efforts and year-end financial status
    - a) Top four (4) members in each event at the CHSRA State Finals Rodeos (high school and junior high division) qualify for the NHSRA National Finals Rodeos

**III. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIPS**

A. Any non-student membered individual who will be volunteering, helping a student member or on a horse during any CHSRA rodeo is required to have an associate membership.

B. One paid associate membership must accompany each student membership. The associate membership may cover a single family with multiple high school and junior high division membership applications.

**IV. POLICY MANUAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND AGREEMENT**

A. A signed agreement acknowledging understanding and agreement for each District 6 student member (high school and junior high division), attached herewith, is required annually.
